

Reminder Regarding US Cabotage Regulations for travel to/from Hawaii or Guam

Please be reminded that US regulations prohibit the transit of passengers or cargo between two points in the United States by foreign carriers when one point of the origin or destination includes Guam or Hawaii, commonly known as cabotage.

In the case of Japan Airlines itineraries, the following are examples of itineraries which are not permitted.

Examples;

- (1) LAX-OSA-GUM
- (2) SFO-TYO-HNL
- (3) CHI-TYO-GUM

Please understand such itineraries are prohibited, as the passenger is both commencing or ending their journey in Guam or Hawaii in conjunction with another point of origin or destination within the United States and/or its territories. These restrictions apply regardless of the nationality of the passenger, who purchased the ticket or where it was purchased.
