



JAL Groups Announces the International Flight Frequency and Fleet Plans and Revises a Portion of Domestic Flight Frequency from March 31 to May 31, 2013

TOKYO February 28, 2013: Japan Airlines has decided to announce the international flight frequency and fleet plans and revise a portion of domestic flight frequency from March 31 to May 31, 2013 due to adjustments to operations of Boeing 787 fleet*.
