## Introduction of Electronic Miscellaneous Document Stand-Alone (EMD-S) Issuance by GDS

This is to notify all Japan Airlines partner travel agencies that various GDS will be introducing an Electronic Miscellaneous Document Stand-Alone( EMD-S ) in line with IATA's requirement for all BSP agencies to discontinue the use of vMPD/vMCO on/after 01 JAN 2014.

At this time, APOLLO (1V hereinafter) and GALILEO (1G hereinafter) will introduce EMD-S on/after 05NOV13.

Accordingly, we would like to request your kind cooperation to promptly start issuing EMD-S as soon as it becomes available through your supplier GDS and request that you immediately cease to issue vMPD/vMCO as soon as issuance of EMD-S becomes possible.

Please note that it will not be allowed to issue vMPD/vMCO on/after 2months from the date of EMD-S capable.

※ In case of ET reissuance with refundable balance performed by 1V/1G, vMPD/vMCO will continue to be used due '996:Refundable Balance' is not supported by 1V/1G. (1V/1G plans to implement RFISC 996 later this year. We will inform you again when implementation schedule is determined.)
